#### FILTERS:

(Procedures below must be performed regularly or as needed to protect dryer warranty status.)

#### FILTER CLEANING:

The external filters of the **CHALLENGAIR 560™** Cage Dryer should be kept clean. If the filters become heavily coated with hair and/or dirt, it will reduce the air output of your dryer and can cause damage to the motors or cause the motors to overheat.

\*Never operate the dryer without all filters in place.


#### To clean filter:

- 1. Detach filters from both sides of dryer.
- 2. Filters are attached with hook and loop fasteners; pull to detach.
- 3. Vacuum or shake off dirt. Filters may also be rinsed with cool water if necessary. Let the filter dry completely before reinstalling on dryer.
- 4. Re-attach filters to dryer by pressing gently in the center of the filter.

#### Cleaning Dryer Interior:

Hair and dust will accumulate inside the dryer. Please blow clean as needed using a Challengair forced air dryer or suitable high-pressure air outlet.

Any maintenance not explained in this manual should be performed by **Double K Industries** or an Authorized Service Center. 


Remove the cardboard fan stabilizers and attach the filter folded in half under dryer handle to intake grill before operating dryer.


- 1. Do not leave dryer OR the animal unattended while product is in use.

#### To Operate:

Fasten safety chain to cage front and place hooks over bars on cage door. (Safety chain should always be attached to cage front when dryer is hanging on a cage) Turn timer knob clockwise to desired drying time (ranges from 5 to 30 minutes). Dryer will turn off automatically after the set time expires. (The timer is for convenience only and the animal should not be left unattended during drying).

#### To Regulate Air Volume:

Turn air control knob to desired setting.

#### **To Regulate Air Temperature:**

**Low temperature:** Flip the top switch to the <u>ON</u> position marked <u>LOW</u> while the bottom switch is in the <u>OFF</u> position.

**Medium temperature:** Flip the bottom switch to the <u>ON</u> position marked <u>MEDIUM</u> while the top switch is in the <u>OFF</u> position.


**High temperature:** Flip both switches <u>ON</u>.
